Festivities and Activities

The festivities kick off with the Kids Bike Parade, where littles are invited to show off their creatively decorated bikes while biking through the upper village. Prizes await the best-decorated bikes, adding a dash of competition and fun.

The celebration continues with <u>Mini Golf</u> as you putt your way through the Sun Peaks Centre Arena Ice Rink.
