

Dive right into the heart of Kamloops with Peterson Creek Nature Park. Known for its vast panoramic city views, this park is a




## star of any mantle, with mountain-top views of Kamloops behind you! And for our dog-loving readers, Rover will love

zooming through the sagebrush as Kenna Cartwright is also an off-leash dog park. Definitely a sight (and site) worth seeing! Valleyview Nature Park


As the largest municipal park in BC, Kenna Cartwright offers a collection of trail options, each culminating in sweeping views


of the Thompson valleys, rivers, and statuesque hoodoos. The sagebrush and ponderosa pine patches provide a rich texture
