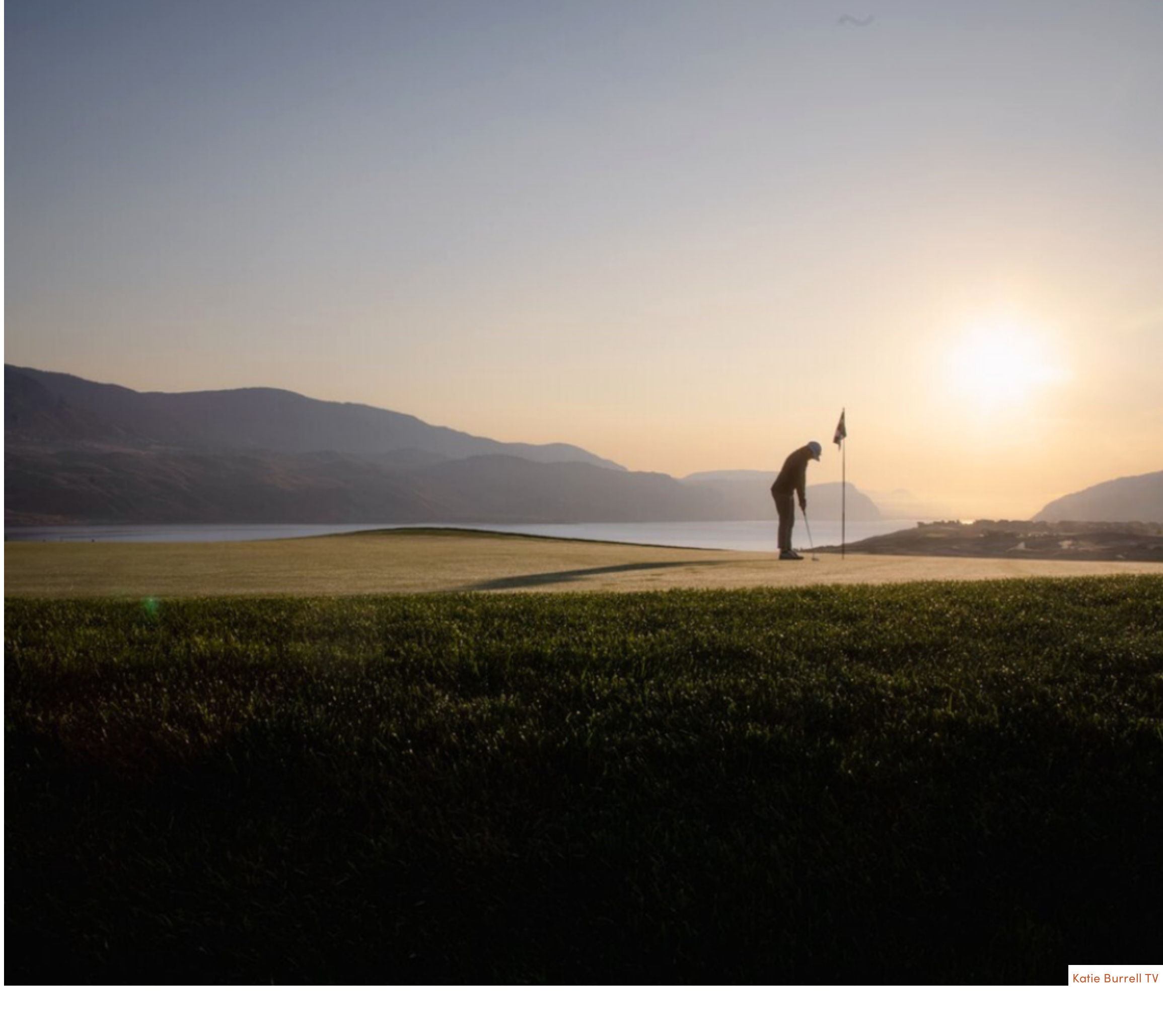

What's the best way to experience Kamloops' fall's cool, crisp air? With a golf club in hand, of course! Here, it's more than just teeing off; it's about diving deep into diverse landscapes and soaking in panoramic views. From cliff sides to shorelines, Kamloops serves up golfing adventures that can match any skill level. Want to know the best part of hitting Kamloops' greens in the fall? No swarming crowds, chill dress codes, and friendly vibes all around.

Meet the Greens: Kamloops' Golf Stars

- [Tabiano Golf](#): This spot is a showstopper with its sandstone bluffs and stunning views of Kamloops Lake. It's not just a golf course; it's a scenic tour.
- [Talking Rock Golf Course](#): Run by the Little Shuswap Nation, this course takes you through a sandy forest and ends with an unbeatable 18th hole along Little Shuswap Lake. Keep that camera ready. Please note Talking Rock Golf Course does close for the season on September 10th, so be sure to check it out as soon as possible!
- [The Dunes at Kamloops](#): Carved from the former riverbed of the North Thompson River, The Dunes' fairways, lined with wild fescue and wheatgrass, evoke the natural beauty of Irish links.
- [Kamloops Golf + Country Club](#): Kamloops' classic, revamped! Walk easy in this park-like setting with brand-new bent grass greens and fairways.
- [Eaglepoint Golf Resort](#): Among the sandy hills, this course has open terrains and views that make you pause between swings.
- [Rivershore Golf Links](#): Desert-like setting, generous bunkers, and a proud recipient of Golf Digest's 4 Star "Places to Play" honour. Need we say more?
- [Big Horn Golf + Country Club](#): Dive into one of Canada's few desert courses, surrounded by natural sage and a landscape that makes every swing feel epic.
- [The Golf Course at Sun Peaks Resort](#): Want to hit higher? This course is BC's highest elevation course. Enjoy longer drives and cooler fall temperatures.
- [Pineridge Golf Course](#): Close to the city, but feels a world away. It's 18 holes set amongst sagebrush banks and tall pines.
- [Mount Paul Golf Course](#): Perfect for those looking to practise their swing, with a driving range and a fully stocked Pro Shop. Plus, there is a licensed restaurant for that after-game chill.
- [Chinook Cove](#): Not just a golf course but an RV-er's dream! Nine scenic holes with a challenging layout and an equipped RV site to boot.

Whether you're a seasoned pro or a casual golfer, Kamloops has something to offer you on the fairways.

Local Tip: Pairing your rounds of golf in Kamloops with accommodations and additional experiences like a wine flight tasting at Privato Winery or an indoor golf experience at Breaking Par Golf Academy can enhance your visit to the area.

With an assortment of locally crafted, grown, and produced items, it's not just about shopping; it's about soaking in a unique market experience that captures the essence of Kamloops and its diverse community.

- [September 24 - 29 | World Fly Fishing Championships](#): Fly Fishing Canada, in partnership with First Nations and Tourism Kamloops, is hosting the Masters and Ladies World Fly Fishing Championships in Kamloops, beginning with an opening ceremony at Riverside Park.
- [September 29 - 30 | Cheers Club Block Party](#): Get ready for a weekend of great music, great food, art and performances in Downtown Kamloops for a community event to wrap up a super hot summer.
